

EMS: Ready in minutes

Emergency Medical Services staff have reduced the amount of time they need to check and restock an ambulance at the start of each shift from 30 to 5 minutes – an 84% improvement. Staff increased their efficiency by kitting and labelling supplies for all 17 ambulances and by eliminating more than 1,000 seldom-used and duplicate items. This new process ensures ambulances are fully stocked and ready for emergencies. The expectation is that by reducing duplicate items, fewer supplies will expire before they can be used.
